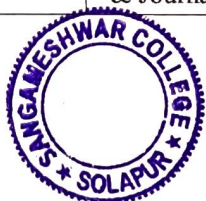
**Minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Academic Council**

Pardeshi Ravindrasinh (Principal, Fergusson College, (Autonomous), Pune) and Dr. V. B. Patil (Director, School of Physical Sciences, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur).

At the outset of the meeting, the Member Secretary of the Academic Council, Dr. S. S. Gavande welcomed the members of the 5<sup>th</sup> Academic Council of Sangameshwar College (Autonomous).

After detailed discussion on the topics in the agenda, the following issues were transacted and the resolutions passed were as follows:

**5.1 To confirm the minutes of the fourth meeting of the Academic Council held on 26<sup>th</sup> Mar 2022**

The minutes and the Action Taken Report of the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council held on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2022 were read out by Dr. S. S. Gavande, Member-Secretary of the Academic Council and the same were confirmed. The following suggestions were made regarding the nomenclature of B.A. (Civil Services),

- Dr. E.U. Masumdar suggested checking the name of B.A (Civil Services) program in the revised nomenclature of UGC list of courses. He also advised to start developing the ABC (Account of Bank of Credits) on discussion with BOS/AC members according to the policy statement and guidelines given by the government.
- Dr. P. G. Dixit suggested to name B.A (Civil Services) program as B.A. Sociology (Civil Services) or B.A. Political Science (Civil Services).
- Dr. G. S. Kamble suggested naming B.A. (Civil Services) as B.A. Public Administration (Civil Services) supported by Dr. Kirti Pandey.
- Dr. R. R. Yelikar suggested getting the amendment done in the nomenclature of B.A. (Civil Services) to B.A. (Public Administration).

The minutes and the Action Taken Report of the fourth meeting of Academic Council, held on 26<sup>th</sup> Mar 2022 were confirmed unanimously by the members of the Academic Council.

**5.2 To seek approval for the third-year syllabus of B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., B.Sc. (ECS), B.B.A., B.C.A., approved by Board of Study**

The Nature of Theory Question Paper Pattern for B.Sc. Part-III, B.Sc. (ECS) Part-III and B.C.A. Part-III was approved unanimously by all the committee members.

**5.4 To seek approval for change in marking scheme for B.Sc-II Practical Examination (CA and SEE)**

Information about change in marking scheme for B.Sc-II Practical Examination (CA and SEE) was presented in the meeting. The discussions were as follows;

- Dr. P. G. Dixit and Dr. G. S. Kamble suggested conducting semester wise Practical examination of each course and it is not mandatory to follow the Parent University Pattern of Examination conduction.
- Dr. Kirti Pandey suggested redesigning the Practical as per the semester wise syllabus and getting it approved from the respective BOS committee.

The change in marking scheme for B.Sc-II Practical Examination (CA and SEE) was approved unanimously by all the committee members.

**5.5 To seek approval for allotment of 4 credits to AECC course at the second year UG level**

Information about allotment of 4 credits to AECC course at the second year UG level was presented in the meeting.

The allotment of 4 credits to AECC course at the second year UG level was approved unanimously by all the committee members.



**5.6 To seek approval for Updated Academic Calendar and Teaching Days plan according to revised guidelines issued by PAHSUS/Affiliation/2715 on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2022**

The Updated Academic Calendar and Teaching Days plan according to revised guidelines issued by PAHSUS/Affiliation/2715 on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2022 was presented in the meeting.

The following suggestions were done by the committee members.

- Dr. E. U. Masumdar and Dr. Kirti Pandey suggested including all the activities examination, study tour, teaching, NSS and NCC camps, Annual function etc. They also insisted in sharing the Academic Calendar with the students.
- Dr. S. M. Todkari suggested that the Academic Calendar must be done according to Arts/Commerce/Science with respect to their specific activities relative to their specific subjects.

The Updated Academic Calendar and Teaching Days plan according to revised guidelines issued by PAHSUS/Affiliation/2715 on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2022 was unanimously approved, subject to changes done as per suggestions by the committee members.

**5.7 To approve the syllabi of B.A. Part-II (Civil Services), B. Com. Part-II (Marketing), M. Com. Part-II (Costing), M. Sc. Part-II (Organic Chemistry) approved by Board of Study.**

**5.8 Any other item with permission of the Chairman**

**5.8.1 To approve the SAN Mandatory Credit Rules, Rules for Add on credits for Certificate Courses and Expert Committee for Certificate Courses**



Information of the SAN Mandatory Credit Rules, Rules for Add on credits for Certificate Courses and Expert Committee for Certificate Courses was presented in the meeting. The discussions were as follows:

- Dr. P.G. Dixit advised to remove the word 'non' written before the title "Non-CGPA Certificate course rules".
- Dr. E. U. Masumdar and Dr. Kirti Pandey suggested giving grace marks instead of credits to the participation of student in Sports/Cultural/NSS/NCC/Avishkar etc., which would upgrade the student's score and be more beneficial than the given credits.

The SAN Mandatory Credit Rules, Rules for Add on credits for Certificate Courses and Expert Committee for Certificate Courses was approved unanimously by the committee members.

#### **5.8.2 To seek approval for change in credit structure of B. Com., B. Com. (Marketing) and M. Com.**

The information about the revised credit structure of B. Com., B. Com. (Marketing) and M. Com. was presented in the meeting.

Dr. V. K. Purohit briefed the credit structure of B. Com., B. Com. (Marketing) and M. Com., alteration.

The change in credit structure of B. Com., B. Com. (Marketing) and M. Com was approved unanimously by the committee members.

#### **5.8.3 To inform the initiative of the institution to start two Diploma Courses and two Certificate Courses from the academic year 2022-23.**

Principal Dr. S. V. Rajmanya informed the committee members that the institution along with the faculty members has planned to initiate the following two Diploma Courses and two Certificate Courses from the academic year 2022-23.

##### **✦ Diploma Courses:**

- **Industrial Fermentation and Alcohol Technology:** This Diploma Course is of 18 months duration and a student with BSc. (Chemistry)/ Biochemistry/Biotech (Food Science/B.E. (Chemical)/Diploma in Chemical Engineering will be eligible for this





Diploma Course. The students after completion of this Diploma course will get Job Opportunity in Alcohol and Biofuel Industry.

- **Environmental Pollution Control Management:** This Diploma Course is of 18 months duration and a student with B.Sc in any subject/B.Sc. (Agriculture)/B.Sc. (Environmental Science)/B. Tech. /B.E. will be eligible for this Diploma Course. The students after completion of this Diploma course will get Job Opportunity in Industries producing wastes like Sugar, textile, pulp and paper, food processing, starch, dairies, chemical and pharmaceutical, thermal power, fertilizer etc.

✚ **Certificate Courses:**

- **Boiler Attendant (II Class):** This Certificate Course is of 12 months duration and an S.S.C. qualified student will be eligible for this Course and will have job opportunity in all industries having boiler.
- **Distillery Plant Operator:** This Certificate Course is of 12 months duration and an H.S.C. Science student/Diploma Chemical/Biochemical/Instrumentation will be eligible for this Course and will have job opportunity in Alcohol, Brewery and Winery Industries.

Points like Equivalence Rules, student attendance valuation, Makeup/Supplementary Examination, NEP-2020 implementation, Academic Institute Building were raised for discussion by the committee members.

- Dr. G. S. Kamble suggested drafting Policy Statements/Rules for third year admission to all UG programs in addition to the presented draft and seeks approval for the same from PAHSUS. The same was supported by Dr. E. U. Masumdar.
- Dr. E. U. Masumdar suggested that equivalence should be given on taking undertaking from the student and approval for this admission should be sought from the Parent University. He also asked to send the list of Degree Awardee students to Parent University for approval. Dr. G. S. Kamble supported the same and asked to apply to university for approval.
- Dr. E. U. Masumdar recommended attendance to be considered as an internal component and hence attendance valuation/ weightage be given by giving marks for regular attendance of students. He also acclaimed to conduct



Makeup/Supplementary Examination soon after the conduction of SEE, to help the student avoid the depletion of one academic year.

- Hon. Dharmaraj Kadadi advised as follows:
  - To solve the problems encountered in drafting the Degree Equivalence rules proximately
  - Plan the strategy for implementation of NEP-2020 in our Institution
  - Thanked Dr. P. P. Wadgoankar for sharing e-books on Academic Institute Building and asked all the teachers to read them and discuss with him and plan for the same
- Dr. P. P. Wadgoankar addressed the gathering saying that 'Teacher is the agent of Change'; hence teachers should focus on academic activity. They should thrive to develop interest in students towards the subject they teach. There is need of Academic reforms. He mentioned the names of e-books shared by him and wished to conduct a 2 hours discussion with all the Science teachers and help them plan strategies on Academic Institute Building.

The Fifth Meeting of the Academic Council was concluded after extending vote of thanks.
