There was prior intimation of the absence of four committee members; Dr. Pardeshi Ravindrasinh (Principal, Fergusson College, (Autonomous), Pune), Prof. Dr. Kamble G. S., (Director, School of Social Science, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur), Dr. V. B. Patil (Director, School of Physical Sciences, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur) and Dr. Ms. Kirti Pandey, (Principal, D.A.V. Velankar College of Commerce, Solapur).

At the outset of the meeting, the Member Secretary of the Academic Council, Dr. S. S. Gavande welcomed the members of the 6<sup>th</sup> Academic Council of Sangameshwar College (Autonomous).

After detailed discussion on the topics in the agenda, the following issues were transacted and the resolutions passed were as follows:

**6.1 To confirm the minutes of the fifth meeting of the Academic Council held on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2022**

The minutes and the Action Taken Report of the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of Academic Council held on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2022 were read out by Dr. S. S. Gavande, Member-Secretary of the Academic Council and the same were confirmed.

The minutes and the Action Taken Report of the fifth meeting of Academic Council, held on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2022 were confirmed unanimously by the members of the Academic Council.





## **6.2 To seek approval for the syllabus of M. A/M. Sc (Geography) approved by Board of Study.**

Information of the syllabi of M. A/M. Sc (Geography) approved by Board of Study was presented in the meeting.

The syllabus of M. A/M. Sc (Geography) approved by Board of Study was unanimously approved by all the committee members.

## **6.3 To seek approval for the revised Nature of CA examination and SEE Theory Question Paper Pattern for UG & PG.**

Information about the revised nature of CA examination and SEE Theory Question Paper Pattern for UG & PG was presented in the meeting. The following suggestions were given by the committee members.

- Dr. P. G. Dixit and Dr. R. R. Yelikar suggested to give 2 Home Assignments for 20 marks for PG Programs. The assignments should be based on Book Review, Research paper Writing/Presentation/Reading, small projects, surveys etc. They also suggested that a model answer paper be given by each paper setter with the question paper set.
- Dr. P. P. Wadgoankar suggested that the questions in question paper should be problem oriented, based on facts, concepts, applications. MCQ's from all the units. Only 25% options in the questions should be given in the entire question paper.
- Dr. R. P. Buwa explained to the committee that subject related special instructions (which includes all the above suggestions) are given to the Paper setters along with the order of paper setting depending up on the subject relative CO's & PO's. He also said that 3 sets of question papers are set by 2 Internal & 1 External Paper setters out of which 1 set is randomly selected.

The revised nature of CA examination and SEE Theory Question Paper Pattern for UG & PG was approved unanimously by all the committee members.

## **6.4 To seek approval for B. Com – III (Marketing) credit structure**

Information about B. Com – III (Marketing) credit structure was presented in the meeting.

The B. Com – III (Marketing) credit structure was approved unanimously by all the committee members.

## **6.5 To approve the revised ordinances for Sports, NSS, NCC, Cultural Activity and Avishkar. The strategy to be followed in case of students missing the SEE due to their participation in their respective event (Sports, NSS, NCC, Cultural Activity and Avishkar)**

Information about many students representing the college by participation in University / State / National / International matches / events / competitions and missing their regular SEE was given to the committee members. So, from the second term SEE of AY 2022-23, college has started conducting a supplementary SEE within a stipulated period of 2 to 3 weeks after the regular SEE for students who represented college in University / State / National / International matches / camps / competitions / events in Sports / NCC / NSS / Cultural Activity / Avishkar Research



Festival. Dr. E. U. Masumdar suggested using another name in place of, 'Supplementary Semester End Examination'.

The strategy of conducting Supplementary Semester End Examination for students who have represented college in University / State / National / International matches / camps / competitions / events in Sports / NCC / NSS / Cultural Activity / Avishkar Research Festival and have missed their SEE was approved unanimously by all the committee members.

#### **6.6 To seek approval of allotment of 5/10 marks in CA examination for N- List Usage and Reading Culture for all PG programs**

The following suggestions were done by the committee members.

- Dr. R. R. Yelikar suggested including the library activity in regular timetable of PG Programs. He also said that the students should be made to maintain a diary containing record of all library activities performed by the students and should be evaluated by respective teacher.
- Dr. E. U. Masumdar suggested evaluating the outcomes of this library activity should be done.
- Dr. P. P. Wadgoankar suggested preparing a systematic format with specific parameters for evaluation of this Library Activity. He also suggested that this activity can be implemented for III-year UG programs also. The students should be asked to write reports, on 10 days library activity like Editors Report/ Presentation/Seminar/ Research Paper etc.

Allotment of 10 marks in CA examination for N- List Usage and Reading Culture for all PG and third year UG programs, subject to suggestions made by the committee members was approved unanimously by all the committee members.

#### **6.7 Any other item with permission of the Chairman**

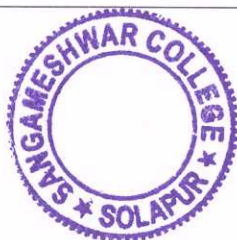
##### **6.7.1 To seek approval for the revised BA (Civil Services) credit structure**

Shri D. M. Metri raised the request for approval of revised BA (Civil Services) credit structure in the meeting. Information about revised BA (Civil Services) credit structure was presented in the meeting.

The discussions were as follows:

- Dr. E. U. Masumdar suggested getting the nomenclature of BA (Civil Services) Program included in the UGC List of Nomenclature of New Programs before the SEM-VI examination of the students. The students after completing the UG degree will not be eligible to get admitted for any PG Program neither they will be eligible to attempt NET/SET examinations. Hence the future of such students will be endangered.

The revised BA (Civil Services) credit structure was approved unanimously by the committee members.





### 6.7.2 To seek approval for implementation of GR for physically handicapped Students

Shri R. N. Khilare raised the request for approval for implementation of GR for Physically handicapped Students. He informed the committee members that there were totally 17 physically handicapped students admitted in college during the AY 2022-23 and the college had started implementing this GR from the current AY 2022-23.

Implementation of GR for Physically handicapped Students was approved unanimously by the committee members.

### 6.7.3 To seek approval for appointment of Ad hoc Board for departments with no regular teaching faculty

Dr. R. P. Buwa raised the above request of suggestion for formation of BOS committee for departments with no regular teaching faculty.

- Dr. E. U. Masumdar and Dr. P. G. Dixit suggested appointing qualified and experienced Honorary staff in case of departments with no regular teaching faculty and forming an Adhoc Board of studies with these honorary staff members.
- I/c Prin. Dr. R. V. Desai presented a short report on, Autonomous College Principal's meet with HE Minister that took place on 11<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023 and the Y-20 Summit organized by our college on 4<sup>th</sup> Feb 2023. The committee members appreciated and congratulated the Management and institution for the honour given by the Government.

The Member Secretary informed the committee members as per the UGC Guidelines for Autonomous Colleges, the term for the nominated members of AC committee is 3 years. So, the tenure of the present members of this AC committee was from AY 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23 during which 6 AC meetings were conducted. This meeting being the last 6<sup>th</sup> AC meeting, this committee will be dissolved by default, and a new AC committee will be reformed, which will function for next 3 Academic Years.

The Sixth Meeting of the Academic Council was concluded after extending expression of gratitude with vote of thanks for successful completion of tenure of 3 successful successive academic years.
